# MASSACHUSETTS WATER RESOURCES AUTHORITY EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT BOARD MEETING FEBRUARY 25, 2016

A meeting of the MWRA Employees' Retirement Board was held on February 25, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. at the offices of the MWRA, 2 Griffin Way, Chelsea, MA.   - Legg Mason combining Permal Group with EnTrust Discussion. a) Mr. Grzejka stated that NEPC has changed its rating of EnTrust and Permal from 'Preferred' to 'Neutral' with potential concerns regarding the merger. NEPC will not be including Permal or EnTrust in any searches. Mr. Fleming stated that he will be interested in hearing feedback from EnTrust's recent annual meeting.
  - International Equity Manager Search VOTE

Discussion. Upon the recommendation and concurrence with NEPC, the following International Equity Managers will make presentations at the March Board meeting: Lazard Asset Management LLC, Marathon Asset Management LLP, Neuberger Berman, and Aristotle Capital Management, LLC.

c) Asset Allocation Rebalance Recommendation - VOTE

to accept the Rebalance Recommendation from NEPC to withdraw \$1,000,000 from Invesco Core Bonds and \$1,500,000 from PRIT Core Real Estate and transfer to cash. 5-0

d) Asset Allocation Update - VOTE

Discussion. NEPC recommends changing the current Asset Allocation as follows: increasing equity slightly and implementing Non US equities through an added Small Cap mandate, adding a TIPS allocation, and reducing the Global Asset Allocation target slightly. Mr. Grzejka stated that this allocation would add no additional volatility or undue risk and would reduce higher risk bonds.

On motion by Frank Zecha and seconded by Thomas J. Durkin: **VOTED** 

to adopt Mix A Asset Allocation based on NEPC's recommendation, as we near fully funded status this is a more defensive strategy for the portfolio. 5-0

13) Manager Due Diligence Summaries/Presentations

The following managers underwent annual investment manager reviews pursuant to 840 CMR 16.07. The managers presented performance and investment reports detailing the managers' activities which the Board reviewed.

EnTrust Robeco

The Board reviewed and compared the managers' performance with the Retirement System's investment goals and policies. The Board ensured that comprehensive written quarterly reports were filed with the Board and with PERAC and that these reports included a review of investment performance and relative performance, a review of the System's

investments, and a report on the investment managers' current investment outlook or forecast as well as strategy for the future and key personnel staffing changes.

The Board determined that the investment managers continue to operate in a manner represented when retained and outlined in the agreement between the Board and the manager.

  - f) Robbins Geller Rudman & Dowd re. *Tetraphase Pharmaceuticals*, *Inc. Securities Litigation*. Discussion. Attorney Gibson stated the Board received notification from one its securities litigation monitoring firms, Robbins Geller Rudman & Dowd, that the MWRA Employees' Retirement System's (the "System) fund has suffered a loss of approximately \$84,000 in a securities class action recently filed against Tetraphase Pharmaceuticals and several of its current and/or former executive officers and/or directors. Robbins Geller

Rudman & Dowd recommend that the System consider moving for appointment as lead plaintiff. Attorney Gibson reminded the Board of a Securities Class Action Litigation Policy he had drafted for the Board previously and after discussion, it was determined to be in the best interests of the System to accept Robbins Geller Rudman & Dowd's recommendation to move to be lead plaintiff in this class action.

to move to be lead plaintiff in *Tetraphase Pharmaceuticals, Inc. Securities Litigation* on the recommendation of Robbins Geller Rudman & Dowd
